Gambler's Choice Obstacle Descriptions A New Jersey Traffic Jam

After passing through the starting line from either direction, the driver may drive through the obstacles in any order. Each obstacle may only be driven twice, but not in succession. If driven a third time, no points will be awarded. Obstacle must be driven correctly according to the instructions below to receive the point value. See prize list/rule book for complete class rules and requirements. Total time allowed 150 seconds (2 minutes and 30 seconds).

Point Value	Obstacle	Description
45 points Total 15 for each knockdown	Drive By Shooting	"Drive-bys" are a heinous act that usually occur in urban areas and have disastrous outcomes. This simulated "drive-by" will test the horse's ability to stand still, and the Driver's accuracy with the whip. Driver may approach obstacle from either direction, halting at the obstacle to the outside of the ground rail. Driver will be awarded 15 points for each " <u>bottle</u> " knocked over for a maximum of 45 points. Do not "shoot" the innocent by-stander, the Statue of Liberty. Only the lash may be used. Use of the whip shaft will result in no points. Knocking over of a Statue of Liberty, ground rail/ball or disturbance of obstacle will result in no points. If the obstacle is disturbed it is considered dead and may not be driven a second time.
15 points	Dead End	Many city streets are dead ends. This one does not allow room to turn around. The obstacle will test the horse's ability to rein-back quietly. Driver is to drive into the alley, halt for 5-seconds and then rein-back out of the alley. Rein-back should be quiet and smooth. Points will not be awarded if halt is less than 5-seconds, if driver uses excessive rein pressure to get horse to back, or if elements are disturbed. Driver may approach the alley from either direction. Knocking over of rail or disturbance of obstacle will result in no points. If the obstacle is disturbed it is considered dead and may not be driven a second time.
10 points	Toll Booth	Toll Roads are commonplace in NJ. This obstacle tests the horse's ability to halt and stand and then move off and halt again a short distance away. The driver may only approach the Toll Booth starting at the barrel, halting at the barrel to retrieve a coin. The coin must be carried to the toll booth and tossed in the basket. The coin must land in and stay in the basket. Knocking over of ground rail/ball or disturbance of obstacle will result in no points. If the obstacle is disturbed it is considered dead and may not be driven a second time.
5 points	George Washington Bridge	Opening in October of 1931, the GW Bridge is the major connection for 90 years between NJ and NY. This obstacle tests the horse's ability to traverse different types of footings and sound. Driver may approach the GW Bridge from either direction. Driver must pass over the bridge without disturbing cones or knocking down any part of the bridge. No points will be awarded for the attempt if the entrance/exit balls are knocked down or a part of the obstacle is knocked down. If the obstacle (not cones) is disturbed, it is considered dead and may not be driven a second time.
30 points	Pot Hole Dodge	No trip to NJ would be complete without having to dodge potholes. The horse's ability to change rein is this obstacle's purpose. Driver may approach the "Pot Holes" from either direction and from any set of stairs (paired cones). Driver must negotiate all four sets of cones in any order from any direction without disturbing the cones or balls in

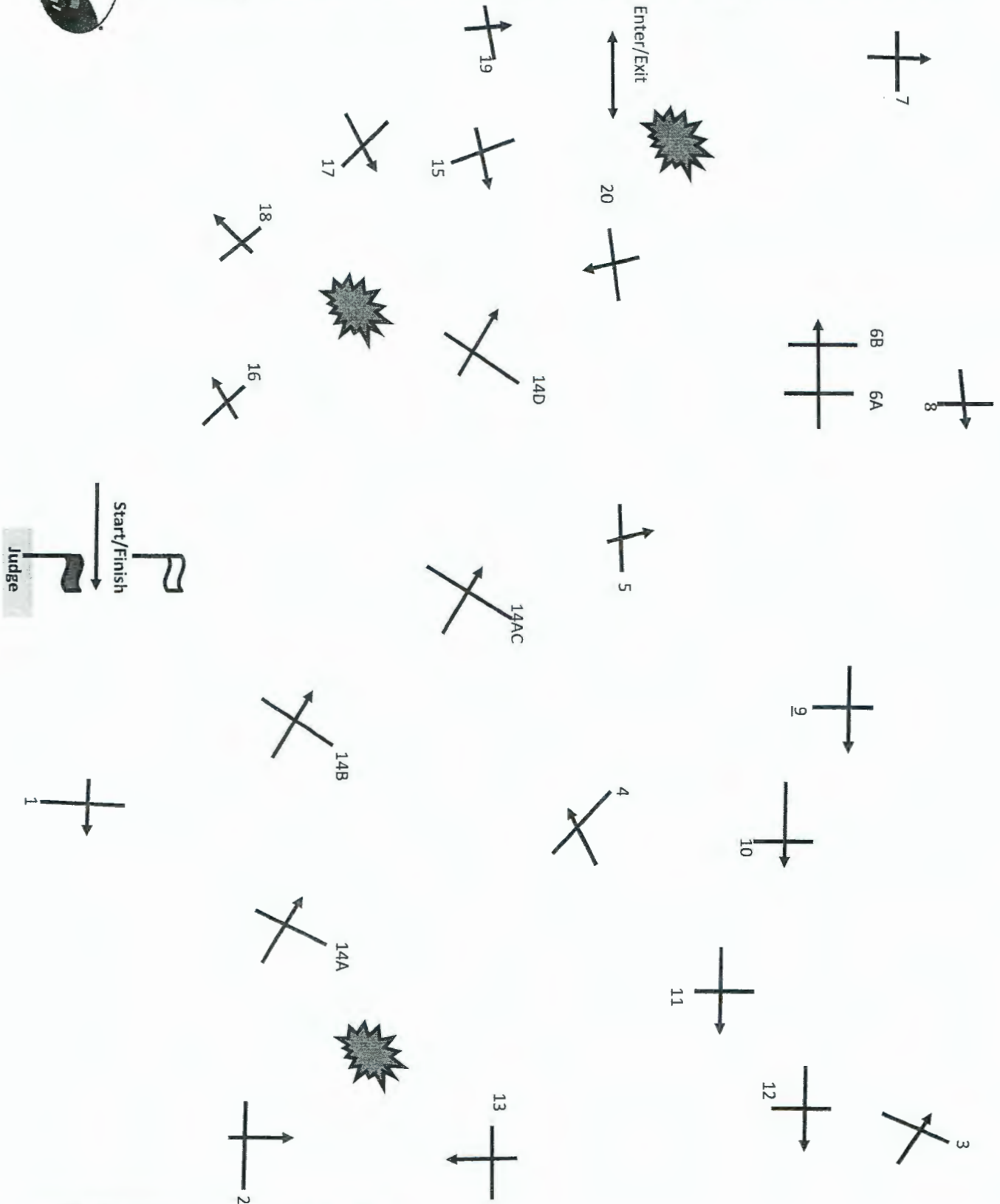
		order to be driven correctly. Missing of any set of cones, driving the same set twice, or knocking over of cone/ball will result in no points awarded for that attempt.
35 points	Traffic Circle	Traffic circles are a NJ nightmare. Driven at a fast speed, this obstacle will test speed and accuracy. Driver may only approach the obstacle from one direction, starting with the pair of red cones. As per the diagram, going to the right, driver must drive through progressively smaller circles. In the center, pivot carriage to the left, keeping one wheel inside of the circle marked on the ground. To exit obstacle, drive circles to the left, with each circle getting progressively larger, exiting back through the set of red cones. In order to be driven correctly for points, cones must be driven in the correct direction in the correct order without disturbing the cone/ball.
5 points	The Detour	Construction is something NJ driver deal with daily. This obstacle demonstrates the horse's ability to do tight turns and driver accuracy. The obstacle may be driven twice, but only once in either direction. Driver must enter thru the stem of the 't' each time. Points will not be awarded if driven the same way twice, driver did not enter from the correct opening or any portion of the obstacle is disturbed. If the obstacle is disturbed, it is considered dead and may not be driven a second time.
65 points	Train Crossing	The Central Jersey Railroad is one of the state's oldest rail lines. With more than 1,000 miles of tracks to maintain, special repair trucks are adapted to ride the rails. The purpose of this obstacle is to test precision – how straight can the driver keep the horse and carriage without "falling off" the track. The obstacle may be driven from either direction, keeping either wheel of the carriage between the rails. No points will be awarded if the obstacle is disturbed or not driven completely. If the obstacle is disturbed, it is considered dean and may not be driven a second time.
